

4 Days 3 Nights Yangon & Bago Explorer

Places: Yangon-Bago- Yangon

Day 01 : Arrive Yangon (by flight)



Welcome to the Garden City Yangon! Upon arrival, welcome by our representative with welcome present: postcard, and Map of Myanmar. Then transfer to Hotel for check in and the rest of the day is free at leisure at the hotel. Orientation chats with the guide for next day program. Overnight at the hotel in Yangon.

(Yangon is with a population of over five million people, Yangon is the bustling former capital of Myanmar. The city boasts verdant parks, beautiful colonial buildings and the famous Shwedagon Pagoda. Yangon was declared the capital of Myanmar in the late 19th Century by the British. They rebuilt the town after a fire destroyed it in 1841, hence the colonial influences in the architecture. The British renamed the city Rangoon, however it has been restored to its original Burmese name of Yangon since 1989 when the country was also renamed Myanmar (replacing the British name of Burma).

Day 02 : Yangon sightseeing (B)

Morning go to the balloon port which is located in Yangon, hub area of Kandawgyi Lake near Karaweik Royal Barge and the famous Yangon Zoological Garden to take **Mingalarbar Balloon for sunrise view.**

The Balloon flies approximately 30 times a day from sunrise to sunset time except windy, raining or bad weather conditions. It lasts about 15 minutes from the ground to a maximum altitude of 400 ft to the sky. For each flight, maximum 20 passengers depending on body weights will be allowed to fly on board depending on the actual weather conditions.



Then continue visit to **Kandawgyi Royal Park** where you can see the glittering Karaweik barge, a replica of the royal barge and surrounding area which offer numerous photo opportunities, **Bogyoke Aung San Museum** which was established in 1962. 15 years after the assassination of Bogyoke which in Myanmar is a term used for General. The museum was the home of the General before he was assassinated. And he is Father's of Aung San Su Kyi who led the National League for Democracy (NLD) to a majority win in Myanmar's first openly contested election in 25 years in November 2015 and now her position is A State Counsellor for the new government. (note: this Museum is closed on every Monday, Tuesday and Gazette Holidays.) then lunch break.

In the late afternoon, continue visit to **Sule Pagoda, Maha Bandoola Park** with Independence Monument, City Hall, High Court and many colonial style buildings then start walking along the street Pansodan, in which he will find the beautiful buildings of Post office, the Senate, the beautiful colonial buildings as the House of the Culture while it happens for religious pagodas and elegant parks and end at the **little china town**. Along the road, you see local experience in ways that the different architectural features, second hand bookstalls, old Government telegram office to the bustling and vibrant life of this large city. And you guide show you a great evening of food throughout the city and got a chance to taste them if you want as there are so many shops for Shan cuisine (Shan noodles, a Shan soup and pennywort salad), a delicious fried tilapia from a street vendor, an assortment of Burmese curries and salads (tea leaf salad was phenomenal) and traditional Myanmar desserts.

Enjoy the sunset at the magnificent **Shwedagon Pagoda** located on top of Singuttara Hill, where many locals and Buddhists come to worship. Shwedagon Pagoda is thought to have been built between the 6th and 10th Centuries; however it has been rebuilt many times. It is here that eight strands of Buddha's hair are said to be kept. The pagoda is covered in gold and contains diamonds, rubies and emeralds. Overnight at the hotel in Yangon.

Day 03 : Yangon-Bago-Yangon (by car) (B)

Morning after breakfast, day return excursion trip to **Bago, an ancient capital** of 16th century Mon Kingdom. Bago is famous for its traditional cheroot industry. On the way, photo stop at **Htauk Kyant war memorial cemetery** compound in which 27000 stone graves of common wealth and allied forces fallen soldiers in the Myanmar campaign were honorably kept.

Start your excursion in Bago with visit to **ShweMawDaw pagoda**, the tallest pagoda in Myanmar with a height of 114 meters; the imposing **Kanbawzathari Palace** of King Bayintnaung (1551-1581 AD). Continue your tour with **Kyaikpun four gigantic Buddha images** all sitting posture facing the four cardinal points of the compass.



End your tour with shopping along the stairways of **Shwetharlyaung reclining Buddha image**. On the way back to Yangon, you can buy traditional medicine products made of preserved scorpion, displayed in jars and bottles of various sizes. Overnight at Hotel in Yangon.
