

Your Enchanting Destination in Vietnam ~ Sapa

05Days 04Nights – Hanoi and Sapa

DAY 01: SINGAPORE – HANOI – NIGHT TRAIN TO SAPA

(-/-/D)

- Assemble at Singapore Airport for your flight to Hanoi, a charming and richly historic city of lakes, shaded boulevards and verdant public parks, with a population of about four million. The city centre is like an architectural museum, with blocks of ochre buildings retaining the air of a provincial French town from the 1930s.
- We will visit **Hoan Kiem Lake** (Hoan Kiem Lake means Lake of the Restored Sword It derives its name from the legend of Lê Thái Tổ's magic sword – which was given to him by the gods to help him defeating the enemy. A golden tortoise emerged from the lake and snatched the sword from the king) And then spend time at **Old Quarter** to see the daily life of local people.
- Transfer to Hanoi Railway station for your overnight train to **Sapa**, which is located among the Hoang Lien Mountains, in Lao Cai Province, near the Chinese border.

DAY 02: LAO CAI – SAPA – BAC HA MARKET

(B/L/D)

- Transfer to local restaurant for breakfast
- Let's once visit **Bac Ha Market (Love Paradise Market)** and you will be able to experience a wide range of different colorful ethnic minorities. It open every Sunday, at around 7.30 am, local minority people such as the Flowery Hmong, the Black Dao, the Tay, the Nung, the La Chi, and the Phu La start to arrange their selling spots in Bac Ha market.



- Check in Hotel
- Assemble at hotel lobby for your trekking trip from hotel to **Cat Cat Village**, Nestled in a beautiful valley about three kilometers from Sapa Town, Cat Cat- the old village of ethnic groups- attracts tourists from all over the world for its distinctive customs and practices which have been



lost in almost ethnic villages. Cat Cat cultural village was formed in 19th century by the gathering of some families belonging to some ethnic groups living in mountainous areas of northern Vietnam, especially Black H'Mong .They lived next to each other along the mountain side and cultivated surrounding their home. Rice and corn were grown in terraced fields, while traditional

handicrafts such as twisting flax and weaving fabric have been well-kept.

- Dinner at local restaurant

DAY 03: MT FANSIPAN

(B/L/D)

- After breakfast, we will start with our **Fansipan Mountain Trip:-**

Our tour guide will walk together with you to **Sun Plaza Station** (300m from Sapa Highland Resort & Spa) then get Mountain Train via Muong Hoa Valley to reach to the Fansipan Cable Car Station. From there, we will take a cable car to Fansipan Mountain and conquer the highest mountain in Indochina with the height of 3,143m above sea level. The cable car system is one of the longest in the world 6,292m. Enjoy the panorama view from top, take your time to explore the place, and visit pagoda, temple and coffee shop.



Next, we will take funicular train (one way) to the summit of Fansipan Mountain



Note: Summit to cable car station, we will have to walk down as funicular train is for elderly or pregnant women

- Lunch
- Continue our tour with trekking to **Ham Rong mountain** . Ham Rong is home to numerous kinds of flowers and orchard gardens. Wandering stone paths leads tourists to wild peach forest, then orchid gardens with more than 6000 orchid plants belonging to 194 kinds. Besides, there are a lot of indigenous and exotic flowers grown along the paths like Lily of the Nile, hydrangea, geraniums, ox-eyed daisy and



cheery blossom. Mountain fruits like peach, plum, and pear are also found here. The scenery hidden in the fog and echo sound from bamboo flute of Mong minority boy change this place into a heaven on the earth.

- Another interesting activity is conquering **San May (Cloud Yard)**, the peak of Ham Rong Mountain at the altitude of 1800m to enjoy the imposing panorama of Sapa town. In sunny days, from here tourists can even see the peak of Fansipan under clear sky with white cloud floating around. Along the way to San May, tourists may drop by Cong Troi 1, Cong
- Troi 2 (Heaven Gate 1 and 2) for resting and photo taking. These places also offer visitors a great view to French villas and terraced fields below.
- Today, shopping free start with visit to the local market visit to local market. You can purchase lots of wonderful products such as handmade handicraft, good quality sports wear, local herbs , etc.

DAY 04 : SAPA – HANOI**(B/L/D)**

- After breakfast at the hotel, free at leisure
- Check Out and Assemble at Hotel Lobby at 11am to Lao Cai
- Lunch at local restaurant in Lao Cai
- Depart the restaurant at 13.30 pm to Hanoi
- Arrive Hanoi estimate around 18.30 – 19.00pm.
- Enjoy your local Specialties dinner in Hanoi

- Transfer to Airport for your flight to Singapore.
